In 2013, with funding from the Russian Geographical Society (RGO) and support from IHAS Inc., he interviewed Alaska Inupiag relatives and friends of two eyewitnesses to a crash off the Alaska coast in 1937 that remains the only credible account of a possible crash site for the N-209.
